## Village Board Meeting Minutes June 17, 2024

Mayor Murphy opened the Village Board meeting at 5:30pm.

### **Public Hearing**

Deputy Mayor Mayer led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

### **Privilege Of The Floor**

**Patrick Wadden** from Arm of Sea – Opening a second season on the waterfront, Waterfront Wednesday, Tidewater, concerts on waterfront, exhibits, paper making, local fisherman will be having 3 or 4 aquariums with specimens from the Hudson River, demonstrates how watershed works. Ask for a donation to enjoy the show, raise money during the year to pay the artist and people that work.

Tina Chorvas Park, lots of events going on fishing, picnicking, kayaking, meetings. A couple of big holes by the bulkheads, mention that the trees are coming out as well. A permanent building going up staff meeting room and hospitality, by Rob Andreassen and his team.

**Bill Barr** (map of the shortcut from West Bridge Street to 1<sup>st</sup> to Livingston St) intersections of two bypasses. along with neighbors on Livingston Street 61 Livingston Michael Asente and Monique Luchetti, 65 Livingston Joseph Sgandurra, Karley Brown. The group shared concerns over the speed of vehicles, vehicles not stopping. I am advocating for a stop sign right before second street, at first street. A three way, stop, with stop lines. The one-way sign there are people going the wrong way. Painting crosswalk on Cross Street, adding signs for Do Not Enter (as vehicles have gone the wrong way). Mayor asked the group to ensure the neighbors on the Street were ok with these steps being taken before anything is done.

Trustee Parisian mentioned Crosswalks and stop signs, off of Montgomery Street on to Washington Street to Cedar Street, Post Street stop and stop on the other side. Mayor brought up the stop's signs impeding on buses that come up that way.

Trustee Reports

**Trustee Parisian** – Freeman article State Grant Analysis for Alternate water source analysis for the Town and stated the Village. Village should get involved and be an active role. We supply the water to the Town and if they are looking at an alternate source. Trustee Parisian is going to reach out to the Town and represent the Village in the process.

**Deputy Mayor Mayer** – The street art minibuses for 94 Woodstock reunion are all up. Mark / Peggy to come to Spring Fling at the Black Walnut Farm, Mayor accepting the Lifetime achievement award for Alex Wade. Alex Wade Celebrate Life Well Lived, is Sunday 1-4PM. Mayor Murphy stated there will be lite food and dessert by Marabella's and Stone Pony. Marjorie provided the venue at the Kiersted House and exhibit with refreshments tea and water and Peggy Schwartz providing wine. The Mum Queen and court have been contacted, flowers ordered, and Peggy Schwartz will be driving the car for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade. Art Commission, June newsletter is out, ordered business cards. The next meet and greet at Diamond Mills, 22<sup>nd</sup> or 23<sup>rd</sup>. They got two applications for gratitude grants.

Trustee Hackett — Eyal got back with the loaner harvester, it's been out, creek looks good. I did have a meeting with Mike and Joe at the wastewater plant, the process control we discontinue the sludge haulers until we can control the ammonia. The users, there are 13 of them, give them two-week notice. We will see if and when we could continue. We could accept port-o-potties. If the board would approve the discontinuing of the haulers. Does anyone have any concerns or questions? Deputy Mayor Mayer asked about the income from the haulers. Trustee Hackett stated it's about 8% of our budget. Trustee Parisian stated he read that there is money being spent on odor control, this will be a good experiment and will be good to find out. Trustee Hackett we have to see where we are at, July it's going to get hot, good readings on ammonia it will take 60 to 90 days to get a good reading.

Mayor Murphy made the motion to approve the suspending the haulers as of July 1<sup>st</sup>, Deputy Mayor Mayer seconded the motion to approve the suspending the haulers as of July 1<sup>st</sup>. All in favor, the motion carried unanimously.

**Trustee Hackett** also mentioned the Tree Commissioner, Ro and John are out there watering the trees, the streets look good. Trustee Parisian brought up about the last meeting HRB we had an issue with the bank sidewalks bluestone, no bluestone, stamp concrete, Brian Wilson had a conversation with National State Liaison, she viewed the Village street scape real-time and questioned the tree surround as a trip hazard. Mayor Murphy the mulch, without the mulch, and leaving the cut out for the tree if also a trip hazard. The mulch will wash without the border. Trustee Parisian suggest a grate, an ornate around the tree.

**Trustee Martin** – The Hudson Valley Volunteer Fireman's Conventions expect extra foot traffic in the village, Thurs – Saturday. Mayor Murphy and Deputy Mayor Mayer will be judging at the Mardi Gra. We working on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade that will be coming up next.

**Trustee Zink –** Planning Board met on June 12<sup>th</sup>, 169 Ulster Avenue SPAF, public hearing is left open, issue with neighbor's driveway. 124 Partition Salt n Fire, public hearing is left open waiting to hear from HRB. 8 Ferry Street Public Hearing was kept open. 166 Ulster Avenue Sawyer Motors Public hearing has been closed and approved.

8 Ferry several residents showed up to speak about the rock ledge, the traffic. 8 Ferry building was discussed but will need clarification. 8 Ferry Street slips were not discussed as they are awaiting to hear back from the DEC.

Chair of Saugerties arts commission was appointed to Ulster County Arts and Culture Master Plan, Nina Schmidbauer.

Trustee Hackett made a motion to Adjourn the Village Board Meeting. Trustee Zink seconded the motion to Adjourn the Village Board Meeting. All in favor, the motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:39PM.
