Village Board Meeting Minutes May 1, 2017

Mayor Murphy called the Village Board meeting to order at 5:00 pm.

Trustee Parisian led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Privilege of the FloorNo one in attendance had anything to present to the Board.

Trustee Parisian made a motion to accept the minutes of the April 17, 2017 Village Board meeting. Motion was seconded by Deputy Mayor Mayer to approve the minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Trustee Buono presented the Abstract for May 1, 2017:

The need for parking had been discussed at the Traffic Committee meeting. A parking garage at the municipal lot on Partition Street was presented and being investigated.

The committee may approach the property owners adjacent to the parking lot regarding additional parking or right of ways. Traffic and Ethics committee member updates have been submitted.

Trustee Martin reported that the new Fire Chiefs took office today, it was a smooth transition. The Chiefs Night banquet was held Friday, April 28th. Full reports will be given at the next Board meeting.
